**Check the StonegateKids Facebook page for approximate arrival time. We will be updating live as we travel.*

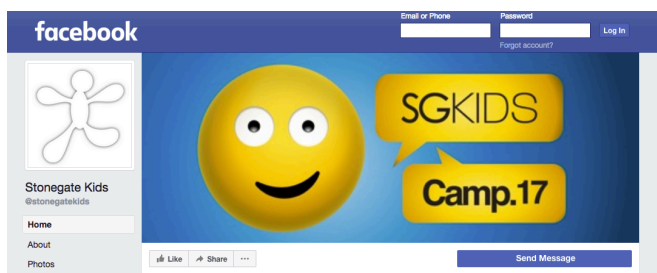


Parent Info

Medications

- Please pack all prescription medications your child may need while at Camp (e.g. inhaler, epi pen, etc.)
- All medications must be dropped off during registration on Monday, June 12. We will NOT accept medications before the day we leave.
- All medications MUST remain at the Medical Station for the duration of Camp. There will be specified times when your child will be able to receive his/her medication (breakfast, lunch, dinner, bedtime).
- Please pack your child's medication in the original prescription bottles only. WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY LOOSE MEDICATION. Please bring only the amount needed for Camp
- All medication must be placed in its original package in a clear plastic bag with your child's name, age and gender clearly written on the front of the bag in black, permanent marker.

Camp Mail

Campers love mail! If you would like for your camper to receive mail from you while at Camp, please write a letter BEFORE we leave for Camp. Bring it with you on June 12 and drop it off at the registration table. Mail will be distributed on the Wednesday of Camp (June 14).

**Please do NOT send any food or trinkets in the mail for your child. We will not deliver them.*

Camp Money

In order for your child to purchase items at the Glen Lake Camp Store and Snack Shack, you must put money on his/her Camp Store Account. You can make a payment towards your child's Camp Store Account by stopping at the church office in Midland during the week (Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.) or at Stonemart on Sunday.

**The deadline for Camp Store Account money is Thursday, June 1st.*

What To Pack

clothes

- t-shirts
- shorts (athletic, cargo, etc.)
- tennis shoes
- river walking shoes for hike
- flip-flops
- modest swimsuit (NO bikinis)
- light jacket or pullover
- jeans
- hat
- rain poncho
- emoji-themed / glow-in-the-dark costume

toiletries

- shampoo & conditioner
- deodorant
- toothbrush & toothpaste
- razor
- chapstick
- comb / brush
- soap
- sunscreen
- bug spray

bedding

- sleeping bag or sheets & blanket to fit a twin-size bed
- pillow
- bath towels

other

- lunch for bus ride to Camp – NO PEANUT PRODUCTS!
- pool towel
- Bible (not cell phone app)
- journal / notebook / pen
- flashlight
- sunglasses

**Don't forget to pack accessories and daily recreational clothes in your cabin colors; it helps build team spirit!*

luggage rules

You may bring one piece of luggage for your clothes and one containing bedding/linens; those two bags will go in the cargo hold of the bus. Only one carry-on is allowed on the bus.

Camp Rules

1. Campers are not allowed off the camp site.
2. Campers are not allowed to go back to their cabins at any time unless they are accompanied by at least two adults or an adult AND another camper.
3. All medications must be kept at the Medical Station. No medications (prescription or OTC) are allowed in the cabins without prior approval from Stonegate Staff and the Medical Lead. No one is allowed to share any medication for any reason.
4. Campers are not allowed to leave their cabins after “lights out” unless there is an emergency.
5. No matches, knives or any other weapons of any kind are allowed on the bus or at Camp.
6. Campers are not allowed to have any electronic gadgets with them on the bus or while at Camp (iPods, handheld gaming systems, cell phones, etc.). Any electronic items found with a camper will be picked up for the duration of Camp and returned to them when we get back to Stonegate.
7. Campers must dress appropriately at all times. Please follow the “fingertip rule” for shorts. Tank tops are allowed only if the straps are at least 1-inch wide. All swimwear must be modest (NO bikinis).
8. No boys in girls’ cabins and no girls in boys’ cabins. No exceptions.
9. No fighting, bullying, violence, mental abuse or inappropriate behavior of any kind will be tolerated.
10. Everyone will help to keep the cafeteria clean, especially the salad bar.
11. Drink water!!! Use sunscreen!!!

Discipline Policy

Breaking the camp rules will result in the following discipline actions:

- Strike One: Verbal warning
- Strike Two: Removal of privileges (not participating in certain activities or games)
- Strike Three: Call home to parent, with the possibility of being sent home from Camp
