As a family, what are some other ways we can shine to those in our circle of influence?



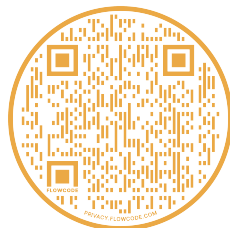
Pray together for the person your child chose to experience the love of Jesus.
